Accreditation

The SPWA grants formal School Accreditation indicating best practice in the area of performance, mental health and wellbeing. Accreditation is made up seven stars, each star being awarded in the following areas where key criteria is met:





- Regular training workshops, courses, talks and events for pupils, staff and parents.
- The use of coaching tools and techniques to facilitate and enhance management, leadership, teaching and learning within the school community.
- Advice, information and support to pupils and staff on how to access internal and external support services.
- Strategic and effective management and planning of performance, mental health and wellbeing services and initiatives within the school community.
- A system for tracking and researching the impact and effectiveness of the above services against key performance indicators.
