

Training Courses

The SPWA offers the following training courses to school staff and parents:

OS Coaching – Junior Schools	2-day certificate course. On successful completion, participants are accredited by SPWA as a OS Coach – Junior Schools . This will enable them to provide basic 1:1 coaching to pupils and teach OS in junior schools. Eligibility: 2 years working in a junior school.
OS Coaching – Secondary Schools	2-day certificate course. On successful completion, participants are accredited by SPWA as a OS Coach – Secondary Schools . This will enable them to provide basic 1:1 coaching to pupils and teach OS in secondary schools. Eligibility: 2 years working in a secondary school.
OS for Leadership and Management	2-day certificate course. On successful completion, participants are accredited by SPWA as a OS Leadership and Management Coach . This will enable them to provide basic 1:1 leadership and management coaching to any staff member that they directly or indirectly manage. Eligibility: 2 years working in a school in a management role.
OS for Teaching and Learning	2-day certificate course. On successful completion, participants are accredited by SPWA as a OS Teaching Coach . This will enable them to integrate and blend coaching and teaching techniques to further learning and performance. Eligibility: school teacher.
OS Parents	2-day certificate course. On successful completion, parents/guardians are accredited by SPWA as a OS Parent Facilitator . This will give them tools to facilitate performance, mental health and wellbeing within the family. Eligibility: N/A.
Performance and Wellbeing Management	1-day certificate course. On successful completion, participants are accredited by SPWA to set up, implement and manage a Performance and Wellbeing Centre/Team in junior and secondary schools. Eligibility: 2 years working in a school in a management role or pastoral care.

Practitioner and School Coach Diploma

The SPWA is affiliated with one of the world’s leaders in coaching training, Noble Manhattan. Noble Manhattan is the first institution to offer a higher level/diploma course in school coaching (the **Practitioner and School Coach Diploma**). This course is a blended-learning course taking 12-18-months to complete. It includes six training days, three of which are a residential retreat. On successful completion, participants receive two qualifications and are accredited by Noble Manhattan as a School Coach and Practitioner Coach. Additionally, such participants will also be internationally accredited with the IIC & M as a Practitioner Coach. Eligibility: Successful completion of **OS Coaching - Secondary Schools** or **OS Coaching - Junior Schools**.
